
1. Courses of Education

The implementation of the Micro Teaching course takes place over 16 sessions. In this course, students engage in planning by preparing a lesson plan/module that includes learning objectives, evaluations to measure these objectives through tests, rubrics, and assignments, as well as the content. Students conduct teaching practice in classrooms under the guidance of the supervising lecturer, following teaching approaches, methods, and media that facilitate diversity. After completing Micro Teaching, students undergo a 3-month internship at a school under the guidance of a mentor teacher and field supervising lecturer. During their time at the school, students engage in teaching practice in classrooms and educational activities.

2. The Regional Tour Guiding

This course supports the second graduate profile in the field of tourism. Certain regions possess significant tourism potential to attract international tourists, for example, from Germany. However, these regions lack media in the German language to promote themselves. To address this issue, students take the following steps:


- a) Under the guidance of the course instructor, students develop ideas/thoughts to make the region known to the wider public.
- b) Students highlight the advantages of the region in the Regional Tour Guiding course through surveys or literature studies.
- c) The results of the survey or literature study are presented in the classroom during lectures.
- d) The presentation results are compiled into a book. Below is an example of a student product.

2) Translation Course

Indonesia has so many interesting folklores and fairytales. This authetic material is considered to be suitable as the source of translation course. Students are tasked with finding and exploring folktales or folk stories containing moral lessons. These folktales are then translated into German by students in groups under the guidance of the supervising lecturer. Below is an example of a student translation product.
